YOUR IDEAS WANTED FOR CALEDON PUBLIC LIBRARY'S ALBION BOLTON BRANCH RENOVATION

CALEDON, ONTARIO – What do you love about your local library? What do you feel could be improved? Caledon Public Library wants to hear from you—specifically regarding the Albion Bolton Branch as the Town of Caledon has approved a budget of over \$560,000 to refresh the site in the coming year.

CPL is looking for ideas from the community, offering a variety of ways to share feedback including joining the *Bolton Branch Refresh: Revitalize, Renew, Refurbish* Facebook group, emailing communications@caledon.library.on.ca, completing a short three-question survey or placing your ideas on a vision board when you visit the branch. Children and adults alike can also imagine and share what their dream library will have with fun colouring sheets!

“A refresh of the Albion Bolton Branch will improve CPL’s ability to meet the needs of our growing community and the shifting demands in library services,” said Colleen Lipp, CEO and Chief Librarian of Caledon Public Library. “As the Albion Bolton Branch acts as the resource branch for all smaller locations and accounts for approximately 50% of user traffic, the benefit of these improvements will reach well beyond Bolton. This project dynamically supports the Library Board’s strategic vision of CPL as “a vital service and vibrant community space”.”

In order to provide more effective and efficient service to CPL customers, anticipated improvements include the relocation and redesign of the service desk, creation of additional meeting space and consolidation of staff space. Fixtures, finishes and furnishing will be updated and public spaces reconfigured to offer a more welcoming space where residents, including students, seniors and small business owners, will feel comfortable learning, innovating and connecting.

The renovation is anticipated to be a minimum 12-week project, phased by level, so that one floor of the branch can remain open and accessible to the public for the duration of the work.
