## **CALEDON PUBLIC LIBRARY REOPENS WITH LIMITED PATRON ACCESS**

*Caledon, ON* – Effective March 16<sup>th</sup>, Caledon Public Library (CPL) opens its doors to the public with limited patron access and hours at all branches.

In alignment with Province of Ontario guidelines, branch access will be limited to those picking up holds or making use of library computer stations. Visitors will be unable to browse the shelves and capacity limits at each branch will be enforced. Computer access will be available on a first-come first-served basis for a maximum of 45 minutes per day.

“The health and safety of our customers and staff remains CPL’s top priority,” says Colleen Lipp, CPL CEO and Chief Librarian. “Residents are encouraged to plan their library visits with these conditions of Limited Patron Access in mind.
